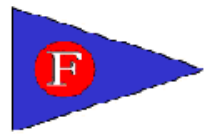




BLACK ROCK HARBOR SPRING FROSTBITE SERIES

1 Rules

The races will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*.

2 Eligibility and Entry

2.1 Black Rock YC members and Fayerweather YC members. Special Activities Membership (SAM) participation for non-BRYC/FYC sailors is subject to availability and approval of BRYC.

2.2 All sailors must deliver a completed series Registration and Waiver form to Philip Gavey (address below), and by paying the entry fee. The fee for Special Activities Membership (SAM) participation for this series is included in the SAM membership. The series is limited to 30 sailors and 15 teams (2 sailors per team).

3 Schedule

3.1 **Skippers' Meeting** - One member of each boat must attend the preseason Skippers' Meeting on January 25th, 2017 at Fayerweather Y.C..

3.2 The Series is scheduled for as many races as possible, every Sunday, from **January 29th, 2017 – April 23rd, 2017**. Makeup races will be held on Saturdays as needed. See race calendar. A Series Championship will follow on **April 30th, 2017**.

3.3 The first warning signal is scheduled for 1300 hours.

4 Sailing Instructions & Sailing Assignments

4.1 The Sailing Instructions and scratch sheets will be available on the Black Rock Yacht Club website and the Fayerweather Yacht Club website.

4.2 Ideal 18's will be sailed. The Ideal 18 class rules will apply.

5 Penalty System

5.1 Rule 44.1 is changed to require one full turn instead of two.

6 Scoring

6.1 The Low-Point Scoring System in RRS Appendix A as modified in the Sailing Instructions will apply. At least one race must be completed to constitute the Series.
