



On Wednesday Night, Feb 24th, about twenty people from both Black Rock and Fayerweather Yacht Club gathered in the Penfield room at FYC to discuss plans and ideas for the upcoming sailing season. Roger Wetherall, the new Sailing Committee Chair for FYC, organized the meetup to present details regarding the Wednesday Night Sailing program and other planned races and regattas, as well as to explore other opportunities that the club could implement to engage club members in sailing.

After brief introductions from the organizers, including Kelly Raskauskas, who is the BRYC Fleet Captain and Ed Sares, the new FYC Fleet Captain, everyone got a chance to introduce themselves and talk a little about their sailing experience. LEARN TO SAIL THE J22

Last year, despite the terrible weekend weather throughout the Summer, seven students were certified to be able to rent the club's J22 Sailboat. This is a great way for those who are interested in learning the basics of sailing to gain confidence in their ability to manage a sailboat by themselves or simply be able to support their significant other as a crew member. The J22 rental boat is a great service that FYC provides for members to rent an easy to manage sailboat for only \$50, for a morning or afternoon out on Long Island Sound. You can take up to 4 friends with you and all the gear is supplied. You just need to bring the refreshments.

FYC is going to continue our Learn to Sail program again throughout 2024!

We will start the season with our first classroom Instruction from 9am – 1pm on Saturday May 18th.

Additional classes will be scheduled as necessary depending on the demand. After you have completed the classroom instruction, we will schedule on-the-water training for up-to six practical sessions until the instructor is confident that you can handle the boat by yourself. In addition we are planning to host a Safe Boating Course for those who need their Personal Watercraft Certificate (PWC)
