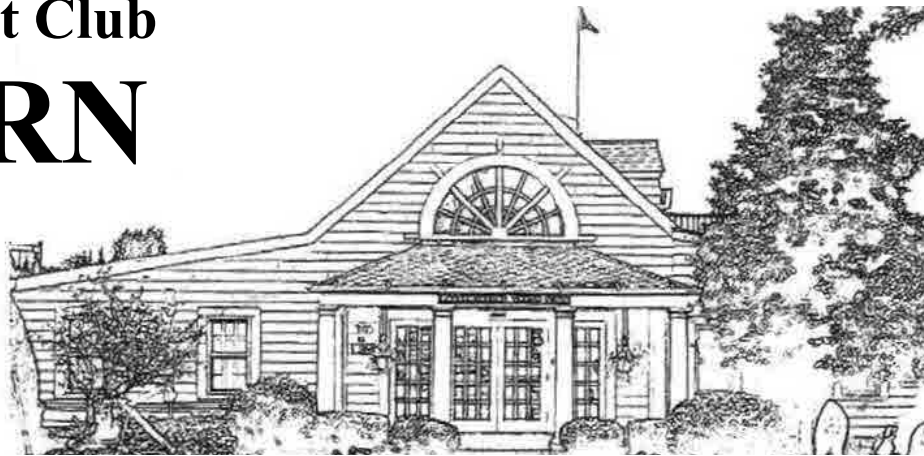

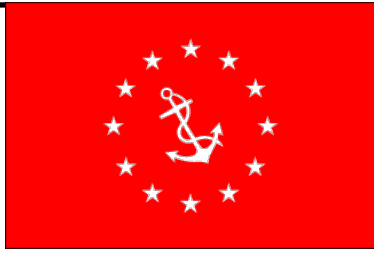

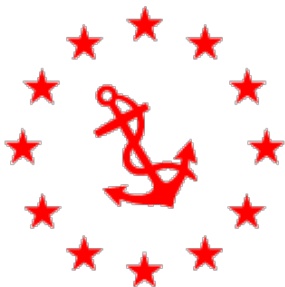
We will be holding a special meeting to have an open discussion about the new Kitchen once the BOG has approved the contract proposal.
