Sailing Update

This year the FYC Championship series will begin on Sunday, June 4, 2000. Entrants will automatically qualify when they send in an entry form with a check for \$75.00 for the "Race Class" (Div I), or \$60.00 for the "Cruising Class" (Div. II), and complete one day of Race Committee assignment. This year we are introducing the "Fun Fleet". This "Fun Fleet" will not have an entry fee, trophies, or race committee duty. This fleet will be listed as Division III and will be scored the same as the other divisions.

The scoring will be based on PHRF "Time on Time". This will allow boats with higher PHRF numbers to be more competitive. The standard PHRF allowance will be given to yachts that race Non-Spinnaker. The final scores for all divisions will be based on the best six races.
