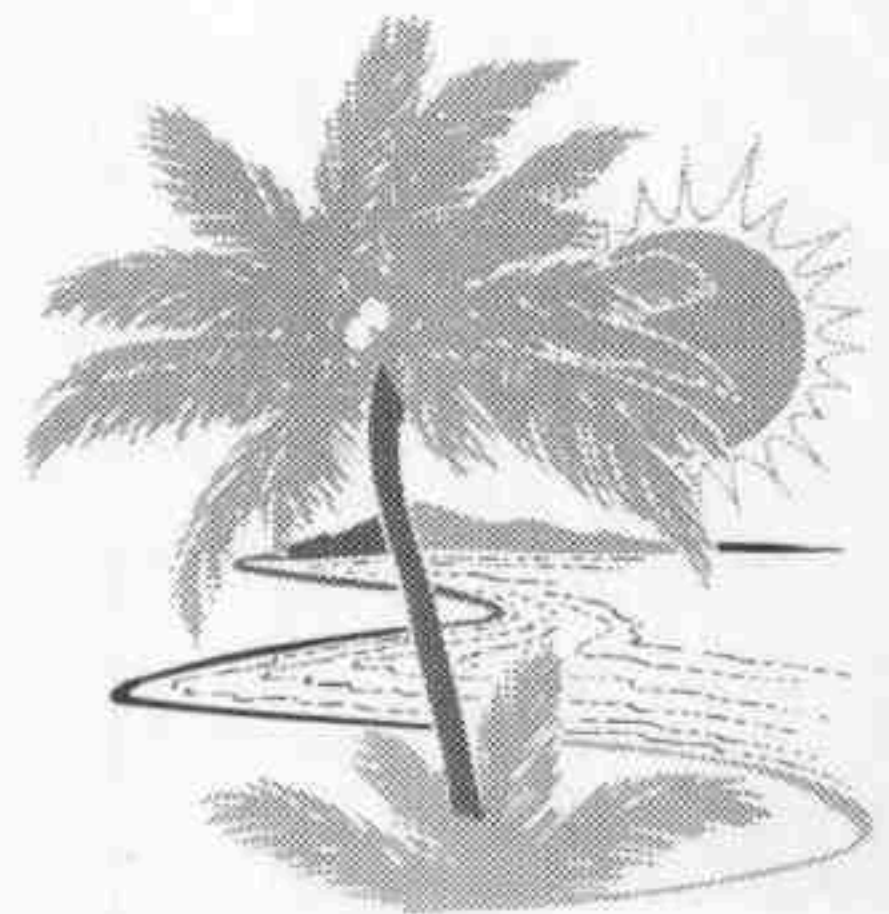

FISHING COMMITTEE

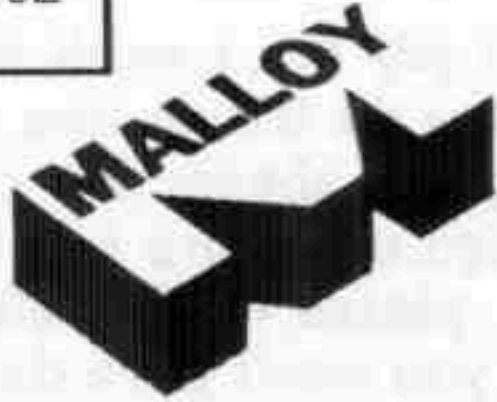
