FYC Membership Card or a photo id, such as driver's license.

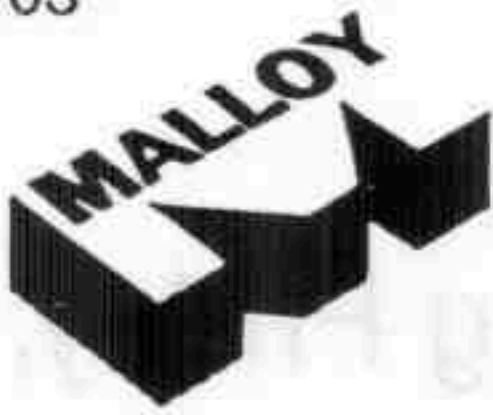
