Frostbite Racing

For this coming season, we are planning to go with the same laid-back racing format that worked well last year. This will have us racing off the dock. This has its shortcomings, but it does have the definite advantages of requiring much less logistic support and more races accomplished. The barge shack will be based on the main dock to house the race committee. As we did last season, we will use a single safety boat. The whaler will be hauled out and stored on its trailer after each day's racing. The basement will be available for sail storage and our dressing room.

At the time of writing this, the racing will be confined to Fayerweather Dinghies. If some Laser activity shows up, that will blend in, as previous years. We are hoping to increase the dinghy participation. A couple of people have already expressed interest. If anyone else wants information, call me. To help here, we have one boat available as a loaner. This is definitely not a thing of great beauty; probably not competitive, but it floats and it's free. If there is enough interest, we should be able to borrow another boat. Even so, it is likely that the some sharing will be required.

I have arbitrarily set for Sunday Dec.5th for the first day. If you want to bring your boat down on the previous day that will be ok. Remember you will need the hardware to tie the boat to the dock. There should not be a lot of preparation work to do on the race gear, but I won't be hurt if you want to pitch in and help. In the event that that weekend is rained out just shift to the following one. As last year the entry fee will be \$20 per person for the season. Terry Roach 372-9740.
