The 6th Annual Swim Across the Sound Sailing Regatta will once again be hosted by FYC. The Regatta is sponsored by WindCheck Magazine, and presented by FYC, BRYC, Housatonic Boat Club and Cedar Point YC.

If you sailed in last year's Regatta, please join us again this year, and don't forget to tell your friends to enter. To the fantastic FYC volunteers who made last year's event a success, I hope you'll join us again on July 16.

Sailors who don't want to race can enter the popular 'Fun Sail' (Tom Lee will be running this event this year), in which crews will navigate an 11-mile course collecting clues to solve a puzzle. Racing divisions will be PHRF Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker and 'One-Design'. SASSR will be scored under Eastern Connecticut Sailing Association ratings (www.ecsa.org). I am pleased to announce that Rob Parish is our new RC Chairman.

The tax-deductible entry for SASSR '05 is \$100 per boat, and each entrant will receive a skipper's bag, T-shirt, hat and flag, as well as five picnic wristbands with their entry. Additional bands are \$5 each. This year's picnic will feature live Celtic and acoustic rock music from 'Camac', featuring FYC's own Chuck O'Connor.

Skippers and crews are encouraged to collect pledges for your boat. There will be a special prize for the boat that raises the most funds.
