


Jim Morley has done the winterization on the power washer and it will be put down in the cellar after Sunday, November 23rd, to preclude freezing.



#### NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING CONCERNING BY-LAWS

The special meeting to be held at 7:45 PM on Friday, December 12 prior to the monthly membership meeting.

#### By-Law Article XIII currently reads as follows:

### ARTICLE XIII Applications for Membership

Section 1.

... "The amount of the initiation fee plus applicable taxes shall be that contained in the annual budget as approved by the membership at the November general meeting. One half (50%) of this fee plus applicable taxes shall be paid as an application fee. The balance of said fee, along with dues and any other charges which may apply, shall be paid within thirty (30) days of notification to the applicant of election to membership. Applications for membership must be in writing to the Financial Secretary, accompanied by the application fee; such application to bear the signature of two (2) members in good standing." ...

#### The Board of Governors recommends that the Section 1 wording be changed to say:

... "There shall be an application fee. The amount of the application fee plus applicable taxes shall be that contained in the annual budget as approved by the membership at the November general meeting. Applications for membership must be in writing to the Financial Secretary, accompanied by the application fee; such application to bear the signature of two (2) members in good standing." ...


#### The reason for the change to a single application fee are:

- 1. Newly elected members are confused when they receive their first dues bill which also includes 50% of the "initiation fee." They are of the impression that they already paid their total application fees with their application. The Financial Secretary gets phone calls from newly elected members questioning the 50% charge. This procedure has also been questioned in a recent membership meeting. They would rather pay one "application fee" up front with the application and have it done with.
- There is ambiguity between "Initiation Fee" and "Application Fee". The title of Article XIII is "Applications for Membership", however, it calls for an "Initiation Fee" and an "Application Fee".
