## From the Vice Commodore

The Kitchen has stopped serving Sunday breakfast due to lack of attendance, however will be open from 11AM - 6PM for the fall. Lu may make other changes to stay in the black.

FYC is a Private Club - One of our affiliated clubs is on probation, has been fined and memberships lost. While we encourage members to bring guests and welcome them to become members, the penalty for carelessness can develop to an unnecessary assessment.

The process, as was explained to me, 4 state enforcement officers descend on the club. First they request and hold onto the sign in guest register, next they ask for members directory. Then they evaluate the legibility (and completeness) of the guest register and speak with all the patrons. In the canvassing they ask for your membership card (or they check in the directory), who the bartender is on duty, how long they have been a member and do you have any guests. (They evaluate your responses). Upon completion the enforcement officers compile a report and the club is notified within 10 days of the outcome. As part of probation, the bartenders are not allowed serve anyone until you show your card or have been signed in by a member. The guest register must be held at the bar and bartender is responsible for each entry. Obviously this slows down bar service. Please sign in your guest and help us avoid the consequences.

Over the last several months, I have reminded our members to label there moorings, dinks, and trailers. Getting the State involved may place us on there radar screen, therefore Ryan is willing to make a "best guess" labeling of the each mooring. Dee has the dinks pretty well labeled and Dave is working on the trailer identification. Then we can billed those members for storage or removal. At the end of the season each mooring will be labeled as it is stored and trailers labeled prior to yard placement.

One final note: Please make sure we have a phone number and emails to contact you. With land lines disappearing, you may be passed over or miss out on important information.

## The Fishing Line




Are your mooring bridles going through chaulks?


