From the Helm

The plan is as follows: we will hold the January annual meeting according to our bylaws on December 18. But in accordance with ARTICLE XVII Section 5, which allows
that Special Meetings of the club may be called by the Commodore, I will be calling a
Special meeting for the Election of new Officers on January 8, 2013. Look for balloting
time to be posted by the Election Committee.



The next Fishing Committee Meeting will be Friday November 16th at 6:30 PM


