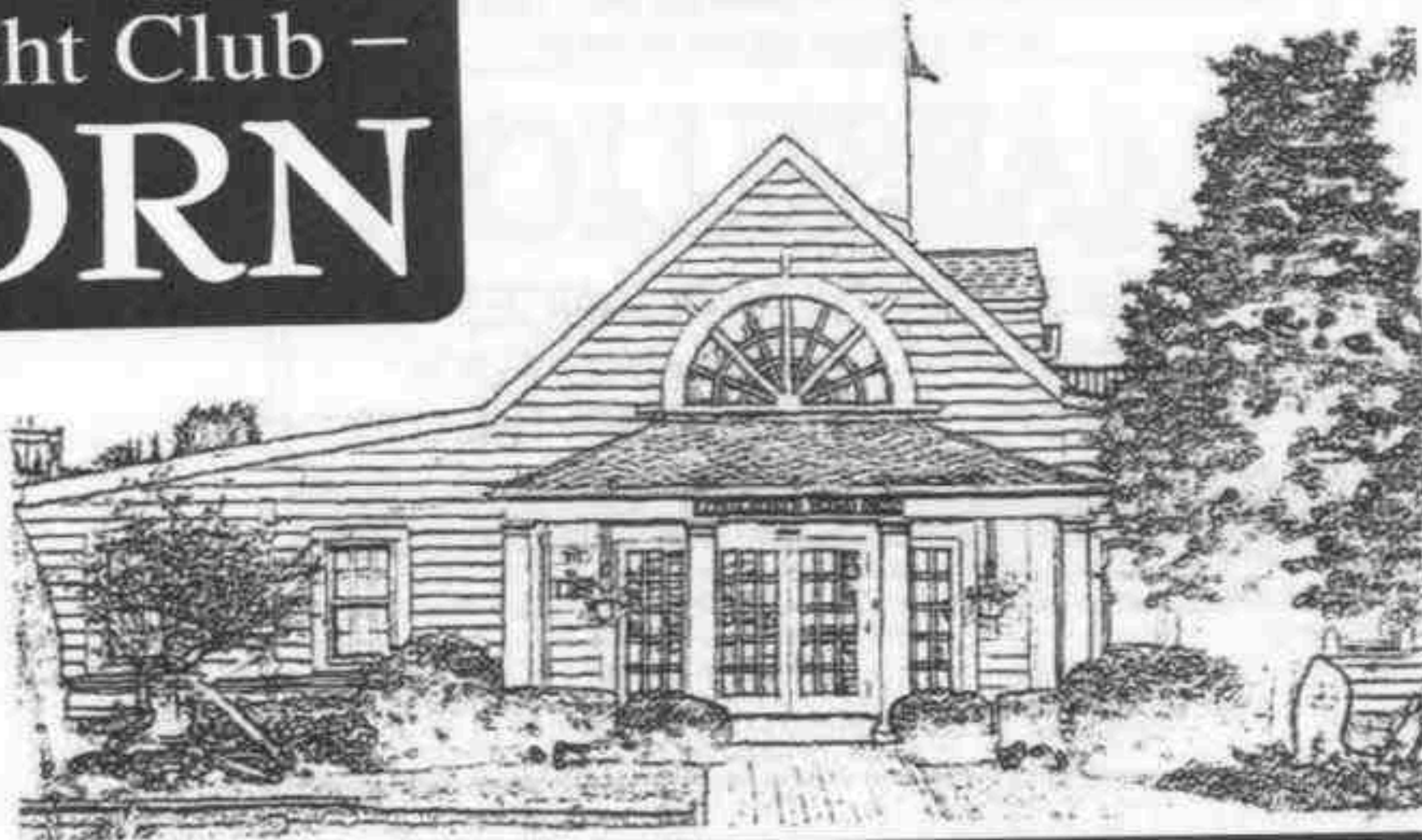

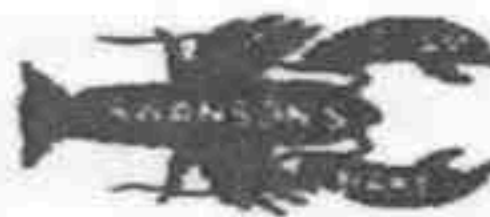

The Nominating Committee has completed interviewing prospective candidates for the elected positions to lead Fayerweather Yacht Club. There were several capable members who came forward to answer the call. The Nominating Committee thanks these members for their interest in supporting FYC.

For those who are not familiar with the positions that keep FYC functioning, below is a brief description:

Board Of Governors – 9 – elected to a 3 year term. They are responsible for the fiscal integrity and direction of the club. The 3 year term maintains continuity of the fiscal management.

Flag Officers – 6 – elected officials who are responsible for the day to day operations of the club. This includes the Commodore, Vice Commodore, Rear Commodore, Treasurer, Financial Secretary, and Recording Secretary.

Appointed positions by the Commodore – 3 – Fleet Captain, Fleet Surgeon, Fleet Chaplain. They each have responsibilities for the successful functioning of the club throughout the year, including Opening Day Ceremonies.

Committees – There are 13 committees that serve to coordinate Club activities. Each committee has at least 2 members to assist in carrying out the committee's duties.

Elections will take place on the day of the Annual Meeting on Tuesday, January 7th. Voting will take place from 11 a.m. - 2 p.m. and 5:30pm-7:45pm. You must have a valid ID (FYC membership card or driver's license) in order to vote. Ballots close 15 minutes after the Annual meeting is called to order.

PROFILES OF NOMINATING COMMITTEE SLATE

The Committee has selected the following as the slate of candidates for 2014.

BOARD OF GOVERNORS

Dave Blagys – 1 YEAR TERM

Dave has been the executive director of the Wakeman Boys & Girls Club since 1984 and is a recent inductee into the Club's Hall of Fame. Dave guided the organization through three capital campaign initiatives, two at the Southport campus totaling \$4.2 million, and a \$7 million initiative for the Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse in the Black Rock/West End of Bridgeport, the first LEED (leadership in energy and environmental design) Platinum Boys & Girls Club in the United States. The organization's total member roll is in excess of 4,000 area youngsters.

Dave is an incorporator and founding board member of the Burroughs Community Center and its first board president. He also sits on the board of RYASAP (Regional Youth Adult Social Action Program) and is the 2011 recipient of the organization's prestigious Goodspeed-Pfriem Award for his contributions to the local community.

Dave is a lifelong resident of Black Rock and currently resides in the Bywatyr Townhouses with his wife Kathleen Pierce.

Gary Conrad – 3 YEAR TERM

Gary has been a member of Fayerweather for over sixteen years and a resident of Fairfield for over forty years. Gary has been sailing and power boating in Long Island Sound and offshore since his early teens. He is currently the Finance Director for the Town of Westport for the last two years and the CFO for the Town of New Canaan for seventeen years prior to that. He is responsible for all Finance, Accounting and Treasury functions, Purchasing and Pension Investments and is a member of the management negotiating team for the Town. He helped prepare, review and present the Club's budget for the upcoming year and looks forward to working with the other Board members with the memberships support.

Chris Gill – 3 YEAR TERM

Chris is a lifelong sailor and power boater. He has been a member of Fayerweather for 20 years. Prior to starting and running *WindCheck* Magazine, he worked as a professional sailor and sailing coach and was a founding member of an economic, valuation and strategy consulting firm. He is familiar with the finances of managing a business and the procedures for running a yacht club.

Chris believes that a proactive and open-minded board that communicates well with the membership is essential to the health of the club. Additionally, he thinks it is important that as Fayerweather moves forward, we continue to maintain the traditional values of the club, "...to provide a suitable clubhouse, grounds and dockage for the convenience of the members thereof; to encourage yachting and other social recreations; and to promote good fellowship among the members."

Tom Lee – 3 YEAR TERM

Tom is a Life Member, having joined FYC in 1991. He is a self-employed, general practice lawyer with offices in Fairfield and Trumbull. Tom sails his Catalina 30 out of Black Rock Harbor and was a founder of the Swim Across the Sound Regatta (now The Park City Regatta) and was its Chairman for four years. In addition to his law practice, Tom is and has been an Adjunct Professor of Law at the Univ. of Bridgeport and now Quinnipiac Univ. Law School for the past 27 years. He is a past President of the Trumbull Rotary Club and sat on the Board of the Trumbull Jaycees. He is a Vietnam Veteran and a Life member of the American Legion and the VFW. He is the Judge Advocate for Trumbull American Legion Post 141. He was instrumental in helping FYC defeat the challenge of the monstrous condominium project proposed for the Salvage property next door in 2006. For the past 13 years, Tom has been the Chairman of the Trumbull Ethics Commission. He graduated from Cornell University and Boston University Law School. He and his wife, Nancy, live in Trumbull and have two adult children and currently two grandchildren.

Rick Perret – 2 YEAR TERM

Rick has been a member of FYC since 2006, serving on the Nominating Committee, Marketing Chair for the 2013 Sail Park City Regatta, as well as participating in the Wed. night racing series. He also served on the Bridge and held the Treasurer's position for the Penfield Sail and Power Squadron. Rick is also an active leader and Committee Member for Boy Scout Troop 82 in Fairfield. He is currently responsible for Marketing Strategy of Growth Initiatives for IBM's Systems Group.

His reason for seeking a board position is to continue the groundwork that has been laid to-date in making this an attractive and friendly club for all boaters. Three areas of importance to him are: 1) image of FYC as an attractive yachting and boating venue, 2) maintaining the club as both desirable and affordable, 3) implementing a long-range plan with guideposts to aid in decisions regarding club facilities, programming and financial matters.

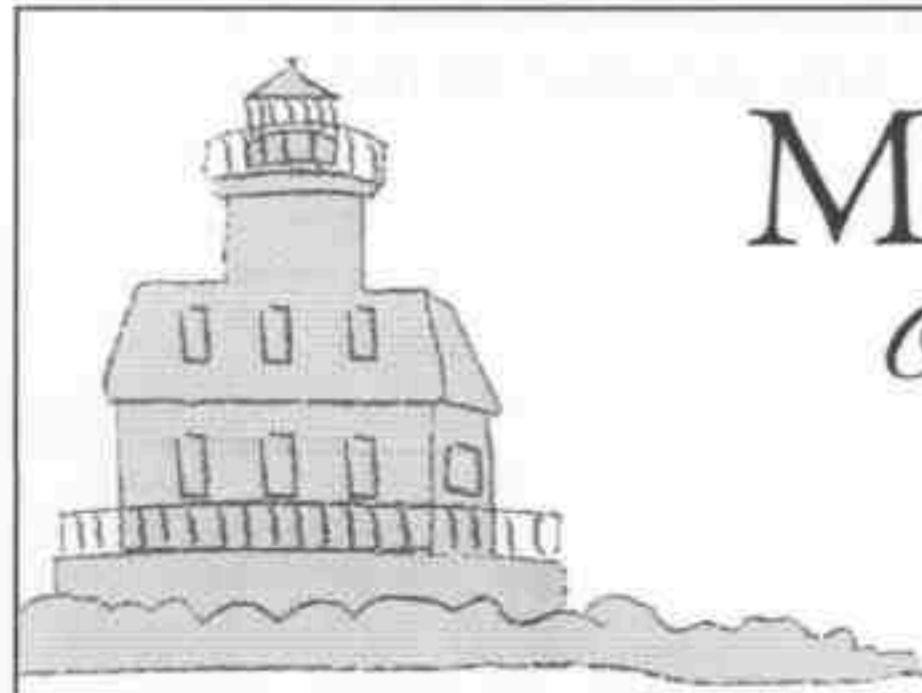

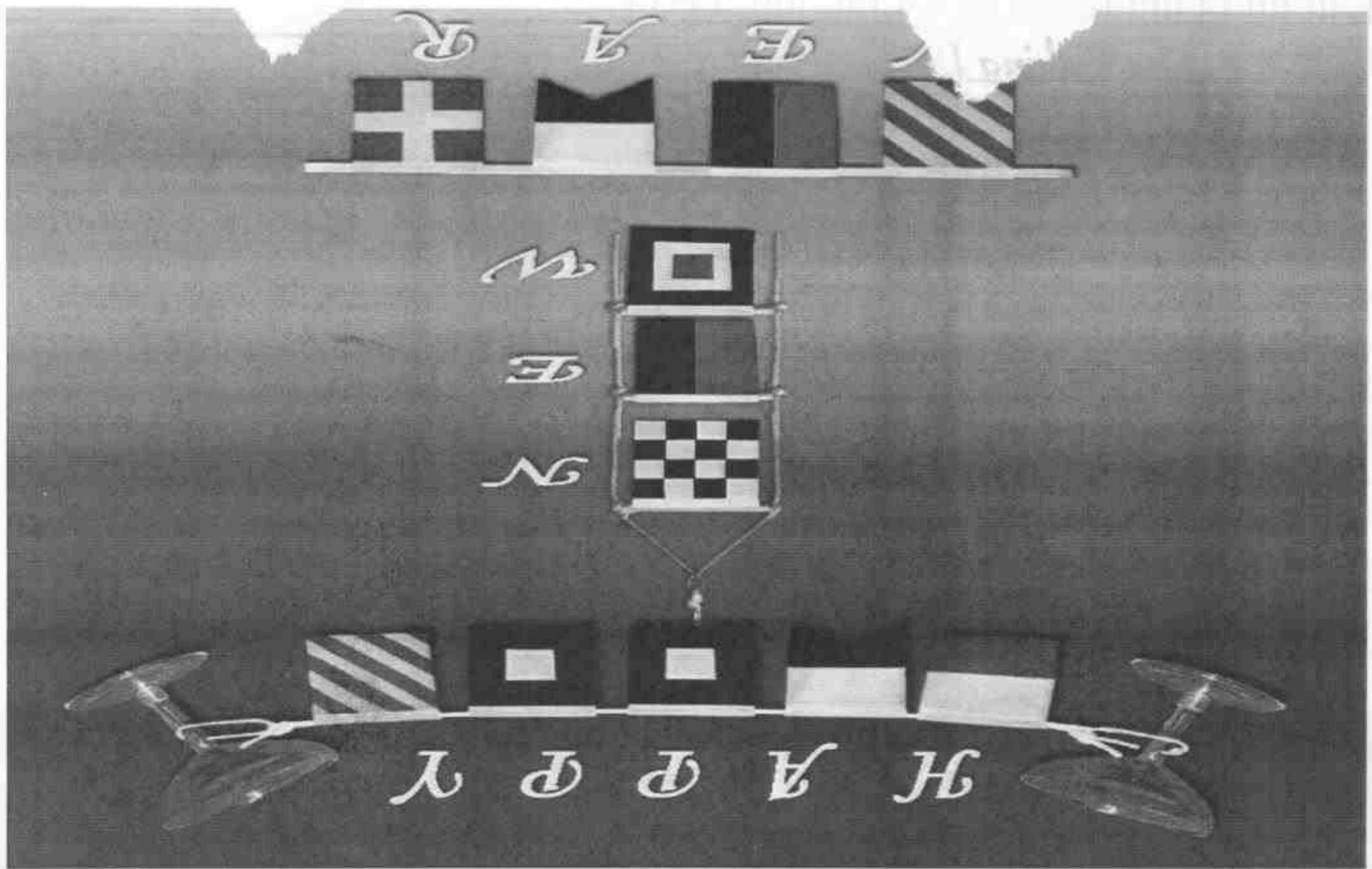

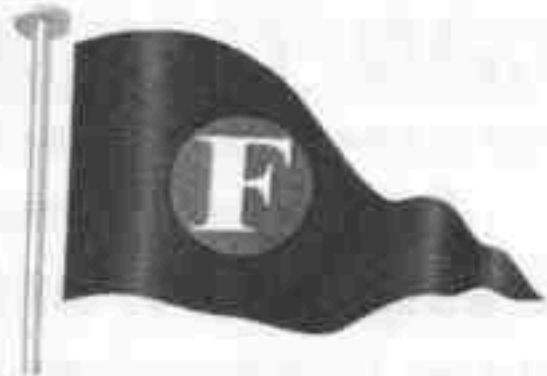
