# **BOARD OF GOVERNORS**

#### David Blagys - 3 YEAR TERM

David has been the executive director of the Wakeman Boys & Girls Club since 1984 and was inducted into the Club's Hall of Fame during the organization's 100<sup>th</sup> year anniversary celebration in 2013. Dave guided the organization through three capital campaign initiatives, two at the Southport campus totaling \$4.2 million, and a \$7 million initiative for the Smilow-Burroughs Clubhouse in the Black Rock/West End of Bridgeport, the first LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Platinum Boys & Girls Club in the United States. The organization's total membership is in excess of 4,000 area youth.

Dave is an incorporator and founding board member of the Burroughs Community Center and its first board president. He also sits on the board of RYASAP (Regional Youth Adult Social Action Program) and is the 2011 recipient of the organization's prestigious Goodspeed-Pfriem Award for his contributions to the local community. Most recently, he served a one year term on the Fayerweather Yacht Club Board of Governors.

Dave is a lifelong resident of Black Rock and currently resides in the Bywatyr Townhouses with his wife Kathleen Pierce.

### Russell Dunleavey - 3 YEAR TERM
