



# Membership Committee

As of this writing we have 25 available spots for membership applications. The total available positions to be filled for the year were 96. I am proud to say that with your help we have elected 71 new members to FYC.

My goal was to have full membership by the end of the year.

In order to achieve this, I would like to propose an added incentive for the month of December. I would need the approval of the membership at the December meeting per Article XIII, Section 3.

#### Proposal:

Decrease the application fee by \$125. The result would be Application Fee \$125, 10% State Tax \$12.50 and Background Check \$50 for a total of \$187.50.

Decrease the application fee to \$100. The result would be Application Fee \$100, 10% State Tax \$10.00 and Background Check \$50 for a total of \$160.

Eliminate the application fee. The result would be \$50 for the Background Check

It is up to you as a Member to express your agreement or disagreement.
