

# **Fleet Captain's Corner**


Although we recognize that most all the boats have been pulled for the winter, there are still items of note to be accomplished, to wit:

An early memo to all cruisers: Next year's Block Island Cruise: July 6, 2019.



The FYC dart league has started, but all members are welcome to join at any time no matter your experience or ability. Games begin at 7 p.m. each Monday during NFL season.




# **Pool rules and regulations**
